Value

The average cost of active membership is \$231.82. That's almost \$150 less than our leading competitor.

24/7 Access

One phone call to an attorney is equal to the average cost of membership.* KASA's attorney responded to over 1,500 member phone calls at no cost to members in 2010 during and after business hours.

Top Tier Events

KASA's Annual Summer Institute is considered the premier event for school administrators statewide. With more than 1,600 in attendance, the event has hosted education greats such as Dr. Ken Robinson, Dr. Tony Wagner, Geoffrey Canada, and Daniel Pink.

Scholarships

KASA has awarded more than \$10,000 to education leaders in the past year to help them pursue additional education leadership certifications.

Legal Assistance

In the event that a KASA member requires legal assistance, KASA provides unlimited consultation with KASA's attorney, up to \$2,000 in legal assistance funds for private legal counsel, and, in certain circumstances, direct, no-cost representation.

Liability Insurance

Members who take advantage of our low-cost liability insurance receive up to \$1 million in coverage in addition to any coverage provided by the employing school district plus up to \$10,000 reimbursement for legal fees for challenging disciplinary action or termination (including actions taken by the OEA and EPSB).

Added Value
